

Gairloch Seashore and Snorkel Trail Discovery Day - Wednesday 11th July

Come along & find out about the amazing diversity of marine wildlife!

How many different kinds of crab and starfish live around An Dun? How many fishes inhabit the low-tide lagoon? How fast does a sea hare move? Who eats what?

We'll explore the seashore using assorted nets and other sampling equipment to look for animals living in the sand and in the shallow water around the headland nearby.

Peter Cunningham (Skye & Wester Ross Fisheries Trust), **Jenny Grant** (Highlife Highlands Countryside Ranger) and **Mike Kendall** (marine biologist) will all be on hand to help with activities, identification and explanation.
