

Sea trout, 380mm, 800g taken in the WRFT sweep net on 15<sup>th</sup> July 2009, at Boor Bay, Loch Ewe.



With a condition factor of 1.46, this is the fattest sea trout seen by the WRFT biologist to date. There were abundant small sandeels in the area in early summer 2009. The fish has been aged as a 3year old smolt, in its second summer at sea; 3.1+. Fish photo by Ben Rushbrooke.

There were 20 *L. salmonis* lice on this fish (1 chalimus, 15 preadults/adults, 4 ovigerous female).
